

# WHOSE TRACK AND SCAT IS THAT?

Read the clues to help you match the scat and tracks to the correct animals.

## kangaroo



I have small, round, black poos and usually leave several in the same place.

I have large, long hind feet and a large tail that I can use as a fifth leg.

## wombat



My six-sided scats are unique. I am the only animal with cubed shaped poo!

My paws and feet are wide and all have five digits with large claws except the first (inner) toe which is shorter than the others.

## fox



My scat is usually pointy at one end and full of fur, feathers, tiny bones, seeds and berries.

I have four toes with claws - two at the front and one at each side - and a triangular shaped pad at the rear.

## possum



I have dark cylinder shaped scats which usually contain vegetation. The colour can range from red-brown to black.

I have sharp claws and a hand-like hind foot; my third and fourth toes are connected by skin.

## echidna

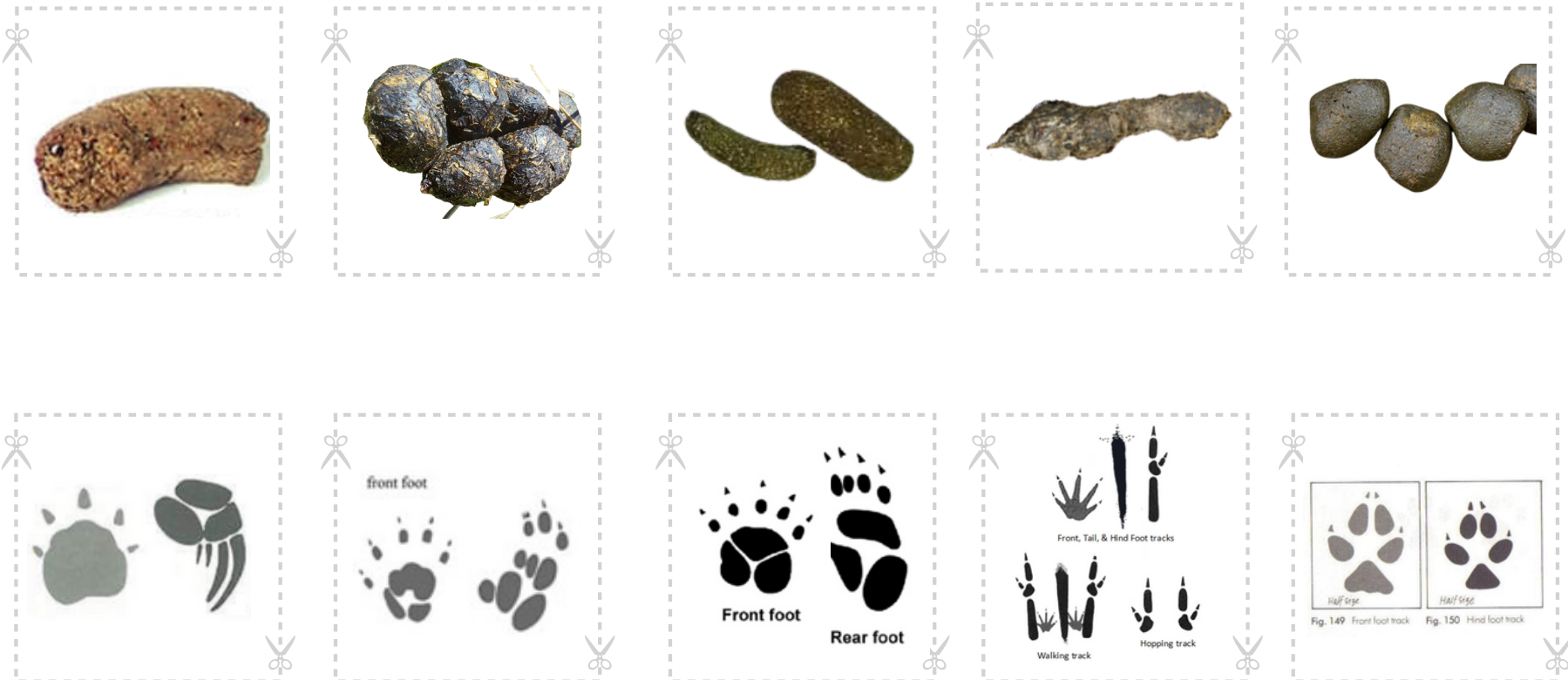


My scat is a dry texture full of ants and termite exoskeletons. The shape is long, thick and cylindrical.

I have powerful claws for digging. The claws on my hind feet are elongated and curve backwards.
