# Environmental, community and school leadership

To achieve the award you will need to accomplish projects in the above areas, as well as complete a challenging program of outdoor activities and leadership skills at Brewongle Environmental Education Centre.

The award is voluntary and supervised by your teachers. You will commence the award by attending and completing the Brewongle Leadership Camp. This is a chance to test your skills, discover what makes a good leader and work on some project ideas as well as have a whole heap of fun with your friends!

You have two school terms to complete a leadership activity in each category of environmental, community and school leadership. To achieve each category of the award you will need to finish at least 6 hours of time devoted to each category over two terms.

You will need to record the time spent on each activity in this log book and your supervising teacher will sign you off when you have completed the required hours.

Your award will need to be submitted for assessment by your Principal and Brewongle EEC. Upon successful completion of all sections, you will be presented with the award certificate at presentation night in term 4.

Remember, this is a voluntary program and you will need to show initiative, motivation, communication, organization, leadership and inspiration to reach your goals!






