

Aboriginal Cultural Awareness 1 day NESA Accredited TPL



This course enables teachers and other members of the school staff to enhance their knowledge of local Dharug Aboriginal land practices, language and culture. Participants will gain an understanding of the Aboriginal Education Policy and how to integrate this into their school culture and teaching and learning programs. This course includes optional kayaking on the Hawkesbury River.

Completing Aboriginal Cultural Awareness will contribute **5 hours of NESA Accredited PD** addressing 2.4.2 of the teaching standards.

Course Objectives:

- Gain a deeper understanding of the local Aboriginal People, including their traditional lifestyles and the connections they have with the land;
- Gain a deeper understanding of the principles of Aboriginal land use, including vegetation management, bush tucker and the uses of Dyarubbin – the Hawkesbury River;
- Investigate ways to incorporate Aboriginal cultural understandings within school practice as per the Aboriginal Education Policy.
