## Teaching & Learning Culture: Aboriginal Perspectives at Brewongle EEC

**This course will build teachers' cultural competencies and connections to culture and country. Teachers will examine the Aboriginal Education and Training Policy, gain Darug cultural perspectives, investigate opportunities to include Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander perspectives in curriculum units as well as giving consideration to personal learning pathways for Indigenous students. Participating teachers will learn about local Aboriginal culture, history and social experience.**

Completing Teaching and Learning Culture will contribute 10 hours of PD addressing 6.2.2, 6.3.2 and 7.2.2 from the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers towards maintaining Proficient Teacher Accreditation in NSW.
